Our customers will enjoy Early Season offerings of asparagus, pak choi, rhubarb, spinach, swiss chard, strawberries, lettuce, microgreens, and sugar snap peas. Mid Season crops include broccoli, carrots, cherry tomatoes, garlic, celery, cabbage, and green/yellow beans.

The Late season crops add fresh sweet corn, wild blueberries, onions, squashes, beets, pumpkins and field tomatoes.

We also offer weekly protein options including free-run eggs and frozen, grass-fed lean ground beef as part of our box.

Every week the pickup locations also offer a popup cash market with extras from your favorite crops. Drop in customers are welcome.
